


A Note from Pastor Jack

Some of you have gently opined that the sound for Sunday Morning Worship could be improved. I agree! We have an antiquated system designed for a time and a worship style long past. The equipment is too old to be economically repaired and is clearly faulty. As a result, it is very difficult to control the sound levels



and textures of the Praise Band and Worship Leaders as well as the Choir and individual speakers. Finding a proper mix of all of these elements has become progressively problematic. All of us agree that hearing the Word and experiencing the music clearly, pleasantly and consistently is essential for effective worship. A modern sound system would enable us to comprehensively improve the worship experience by providing the ability to control each mic and instrument separately and with much deeper equalization. We are also working on placing a sound shield around the drums or replacing them with an electronic set to better control the volume. The new system and the drum changes will also eliminate feedback and abrupt volume changes and would finally give us the chance to correct and adjust the sound much quicker "on the fly". With a new system, we will also be able to attain a full sound with less volume overall and eliminate any muddiness from individual speaking mics. Replacing and modernizing the sound system is part of our Blue Water Commitment and while we work on the resources to do so, be assured that we "hear" your concerns and will address them as much as possible within the limits of our current equipment.

By filling a shoebox, you can be part of sending the Gospel to more than 100 countries, including refugee centers. Bring your shoe boxes to worship on Sunday, November 12, and put them on the altar.

• Relay Week - Monday, November 13 through Monday, November 10

Church on the Drive will be a Relay Station again this year. A relay station is a designated drop-off location for shoeboxes that have been collected by other churches, individuals, and community organizations. They bring their boxes here and we send them on to the next level, in Atlanta.

We will need volunteers during that week to unload and re-load vehicles, put labels and rubber bands on the shoe boxes, assign numbers to the shoe boxes, provide snacks for volunteers, and greet people as they come to drop off shoe boxes from their church or community organization. • Trip to Atlanta Processing Center - Wednesday, November 29 - Saturday, December 2

If you really want to immerse yourself in Operation Christmas Child, consider taking the trip to the Atlanta Processing Center this year. While there, you will help sort,

inspect, package, and ship millions of shoeboxes all over the world. This year, the trip starts on November 29 and ends on December 2.

At every shoebox outreach event the children and their families hear the gospel. What a blessing and opportunity we have to be a part in this great evangelistic outreach. Some changes this year - no candy or toothpaste may be included and the shipping cost is \$9.00 per shoebox. prayer times will have a focus of ministry or mission and will sometimes include a guest speaker. Everyone (men, women, youth, and children) is invited to participate.






