

Come spend a relaxing weekend with us at beautiful Lake Louisa State Park in Lake County this fall. A short drive from Orlando, this 4,500-acre state park is noted for its beautiful lakes, rolling hills and scenic landscapes. You can choose to stay in one of the comfortable cabins or if you have an RV or tent there are plenty of campsites available in close proximity. If you are interested in joining us you will

The cabins are 2 bedroom/1 bath and sleep up to 6 (1 queen, 1 double and 2 single beds) with a kitchen - cost \$120/night. The campsites have both 30 and 50 amp hooks ups, can accommodate 1 RV or 2 tents and up to 8 people for a cost of-\$24/night. 



Over the past couple of months, many of you took time to give the committee valuable input on our church constitution. Thank you! Your feedback included:

·32 online survey responses, providing over 2500 words of commentary on the church's proceedings



- · 20 interviews
- · 42 church members at the first Listening Forum
- ·30 church members at the second Listening Forum

In May, the committee read, studied, analyzed, prayed about, and met to discuss your feedback. There is a clear call to move forward with recommending revisions to the constitution. The committee will share specifics of the revision criteria, based on your

feedback, at the June business meeting.
